DANCING BEAR ASPEN BEGINS CONSTRUCTION AT NEW MOUNTAINSIDE BUILDING

*Dancing Bear Aspen's Final Phase of Construction
Symbolizes Reinvigoration For Aspen's Resort Development Community*



ASPEN, COLO. – (Dec 1, 2014) – Construction of the Dancing Bear Aspen Mountainside building is now officially underway, signifying progress for Aspen's resort community. The building is the second and final phase of the private residence club and the first resort development project in Aspen to undergo any construction since the recession's impact in 2008.

Construction, by Colorado-based R.A. Nelson, is expected to be completed for the 2015/2016 ski season, with a new restaurant space and residences for Owners of the downtown Aspen private residence club. Construction begins with a tunnel connecting the Mountainside and Parkside buildings underneath Durant Ave., providing safe and seamless access for Owners, guests and service staff of Dancing Bear Aspen. Improvements to City of Aspen utilities will be made at the same time. Construction will then be focused on building out the exterior of the existing steel frame of the Mountainside building and then completion of the interiors.

The Dancing Bear Mountainside building features ten 3-bedroom, 3.5 bathroom 1,800-2,000 sq. ft. residences sold in 1/8th fractional interests starting from \$785,000. Additionally, a stunning 3,200 sq. ft. penthouse residence with 4 bedrooms, 4.5 bathrooms and over 3,000 sq. ft. of outdoor living space with 360-degree views, offers one of the largest rooftop decks for a private residence in downtown Aspen. In addition to amenities in the existing Parkside building, Owners will have access to new features that will include a spa grotto and steam room,

underground parking garage, owner ski locker room, reception area, as well as a full service restaurant and bar. The building also features two employee-housing units that will be available for staff of Dancing Bear Aspen.

In May 2012, Timbers Resorts was appointed to launch the initial sales and marketing for the residences' first building, acquired by Sunrise Company in February 2012. All available interests sold out in less than two years, representing 28% percent of total fractional real estate transactions in Aspen during that time.

While construction is underway, the Dancing Bear Mountainside building site will be surrounded with public art created by Aspen Community School students. The Mountainside Mural contains 94 art masterpieces featuring whimsical dancing bears that were created by Kindergarten through 6th grade students as part of a spring art project to help raise awareness of the school's "I Believe" campus fundraising campaign.

"We're excited to bring this project to its final phase with construction underway," said Randall Bone, Chief Executive Officer for project developer Sunrise Company. "Since taking over ownership of Dancing Bear Aspen in 2012, we've been looking forward to bringing resort development vitality back to the community."

The second building has been designed by [O'Bryan Partnership Inc.](#) architects with interior design by [NCH Design](#) of Aspen, echoing the mountain-modern style of the original nine residences in the Parkside building.

Owners at Dancing Bear Aspen enjoy year-round resort living in the heart of downtown Aspen, with luxurious amenities and services.
